A Message from the President

At HCA Healthcare West Florida, we are no stranger to threats. For more than 52 years, managing life-threatening situations has been integral to our mission. This legacy has prepared us well for the pandemic that has changed our world.

Our history of engineering best practices, along with the collaborative relationships we have developed with local and federal health agencies, and our scale to reallocate resources where the need is greatest, have all contributed to our success in managing through this pandemic to ensure our communities continue to receive high quality healthcare services.

The attached report is a brief reflection of our accomplishments in 2019, and our efforts to reimagine care in the post-pandemic world we are navigating. In many ways, last year feels like a long time ago, yet our foundation of resilience continues to inspire us to care for our patients, our communities, and each other.

With a strong focus on our clinical programs, we expanded robotic capabilities at most of our hospitals and added Left Ventricular Assist Device (LVAD) and heart transplant services to our Division. Telehealth programs, including specialty programs like tele-psychiatry and tele-neurology, allow us to connect directly from our ERs and hospitals to specialty physicians for accurate and immediate diagnoses.

Access to emergency care expanded to 27 locations, with new freestanding ER 24/7® facilities in Riverview, Lakeland, and Wesley Chapel.

We continue to build our nursing and physician teams, through our partnership with the Galen School of Nursing and expanding our graduate medical education (GME) programs. Today nine of our facilities are physician teaching hospitals, attracting the next generation of doctors to our communities along the west coast. Many of you are aware we also opened the state-of-the-art Center for Clinical Advancement in the Brandon area in 2019. This is a simulation facility allowing our caregivers to work with the latest training technology.

As we move forward, I want you to know that we are confident we will provide you with high quality healthcare services, safely and conveniently. We will continue to work with our caregivers, physicians, local and state leaders, and other area healthcare systems to ensure excellence for the patients and communities we are privileged to serve.

PUTTING PATIENTS FIRST

We use our scale and skill to deliver superior, patient-centered care.

81% | Our U.S. hospitals consistently receive safety grades that top the national average. In the fall of 2019, 81% received an 'A' or a 'B' from The Leapfrog Group, versus 58% of non-HCA Healthcare U.S. hospitals.

3.8M | Our pioneering SPOT (Sepsis Prediction and Optimization of Therapy) technology detects sepsis earlier, speeding treatment of this potentially deadly condition. SPOT was used to monitor 3.8 million patients in 2018 and was recognized in 2019 with Red Hat's Innovator of the Year Award.

31% & 40% | In 2019, our ABATE (Active Bathing to Eliminate Infection) study—conducted in 53 HCA Healthcare hospitals and involving 330,000 patients—showed a 31% reduction in bloodstream infections in non-ICU patients with devices and a 40% reduction in infections from antibiotic-resistant bacteria.



SERVING OUR COMMUNITIES

We invest in creating healthier communities where patients live and caregivers serve.

\$4.2B | In 2019, we invested \$4.2 billion in capital to expand services or bring new services to hundreds of areas. Also in 2018, we employed more than 262,000 people, with combined payroll and benefits of \$21.4 billion.

3,800 | Our caregivers volunteered 107,000 hours and donated more than \$10 million to more than 3,800 organizations in 2019; as an organization, we donated \$4.1 million in matching funds.

\$3B+ | In 2019, we spent more than \$3 billion for delivery of charity care, uninsured discounts and other uncompensated care, and we provided more than \$45 million in charitable contributions across the enterprise.



SUPPORTING OUR CAREGIVERS

We invest in technology, education, benefits and infrastructure to support our caregivers and their families.

\$300M | In 2019, we committed up to \$300 million (over three years) for paid family leave, tuition reimbursement, student loan assistance, scholarships and other programs.

Scholars | The HCA Healthcare Scholars Program offers education scholarships for dependent children of eligible caregivers.

35k | The HCA Healthcare Hope Fund assists colleagues impacted by natural disasters, health conditions, domestic violence, death of a loved one and other hardships. Since its inception, the Hope Fund has distributed more than 35,000 grants totaling more than \$56 million in aid.

80 | As a member of Practice Greenhealth, we've received more than 80 Environmental Excellence Awards.

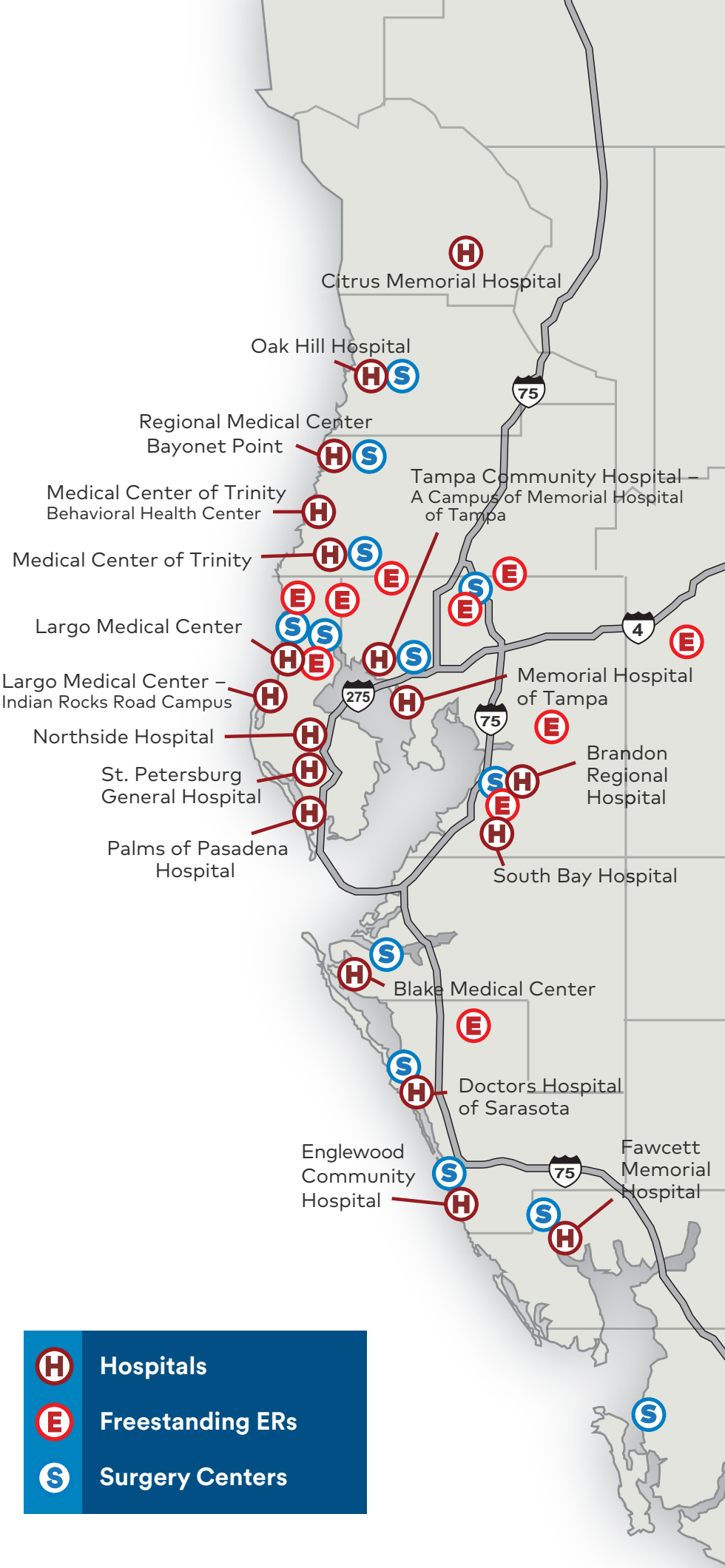
10 | For the 10th consecutive year (through 2018), HCA Healthcare has been recognized by the Ethisphere Institute as one of the World's Most Ethical Companies.

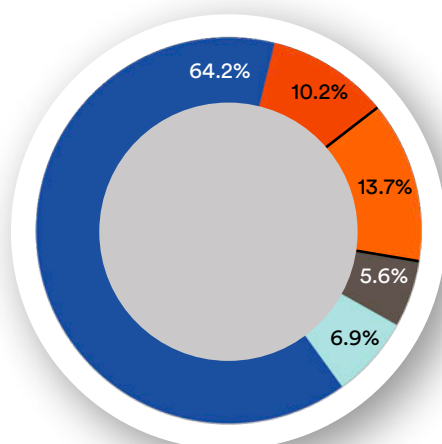

Our Physicians

HCA Healthcare is a physician-empowered company where a passion for clinical excellence and patient-centered care combine with scale and shared resources to advance the practice of medicine.

We are fortunate to have more than 3,400 physicians committed to supporting our clinical and safety agendas in communities along Florida's west coast. From small practices to multispecialty groups, our physicians offer a wide range of office settings and locations for patients to receive healthcare services. This includes HCA Physician Services Group, which is comprised of locally managed practices.

Within our hospitals, a number of specialists work closely with our primary care physicians to support the unique needs of patients in the acute care setting. Together we share the goal of improving the lives of the patients we serve through collaboration and best practices.

Graduate Medical Education

HCA Healthcare is the largest sponsor of graduate medical education in Florida. Through these efforts, we are addressing physician shortages and attracting a new generation of physicians to our state.

More than 650 residents and fellows participated in our 2019-2020 academic year training. Brandon Regional Hospital's program earned the hospital the prestigious Top Teaching Hospital recognition from the Leapfrog Group, while Oak Hill Hospital joined Brandon, Largo Medical Center, and Regional Medical Center Bayonet Point in achieving state designation as a Statutory Teaching Hospital. Additionally, in 2019 we were approved to add Radiology, Infectious Diseases, Addiction Medicine,

and Hospital & Palliative Medicine programs to our 19 existing training specialty areas. These include Anesthesiology, Dermatology, Emergency Medicine, Internal Medicine and subspecialties including Cardiology, Interventional Cardiology, Endocrinology, Gastroenterology, Geriatrics, Pulmonology/Critical Care, Rheumatology, General Surgery, Obstetrics/Gynecology, Ophthalmology, Orthopedic Surgery, Pathology, Podiatry, Psychiatry, and Transitional Year.

A special thank you to the many communities we serve, for the outpouring of support extended to our hospitals and our caregivers. It is truly our privilege to serve you.

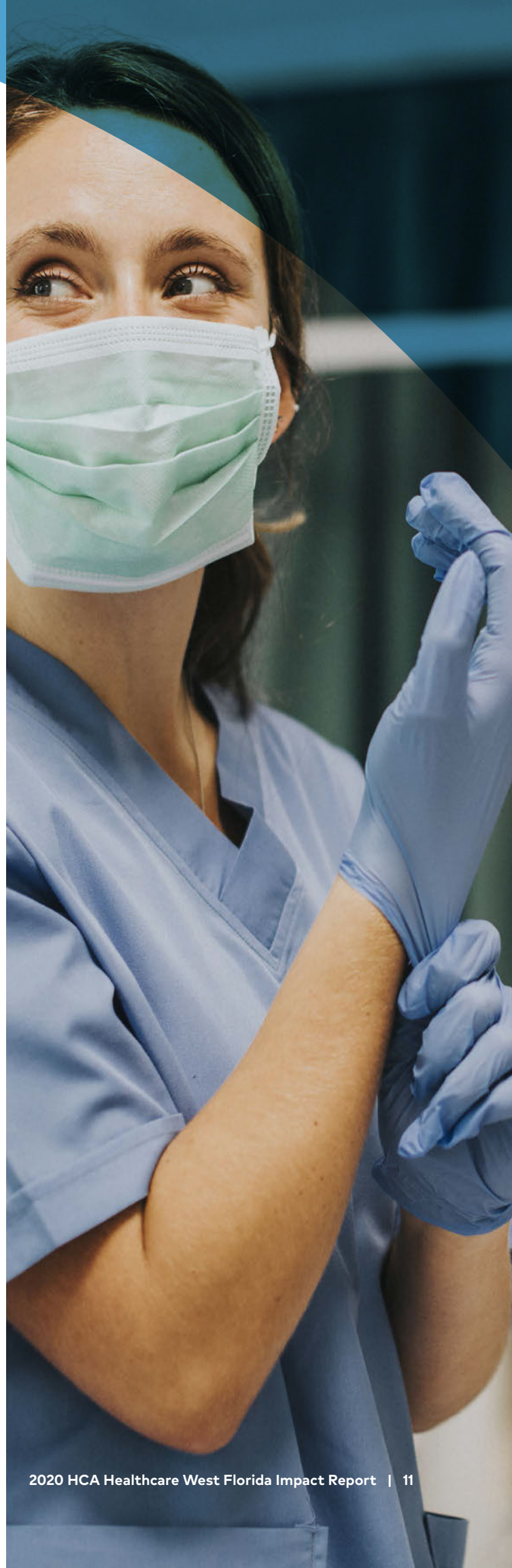
The Year of the Nurse

2020 was designated The Year of the Nurse. How prophetic, as the pandemic is placing an even larger spotlight on nurses, who are on the frontline around the world caring for their patients and their communities.

In the HCA Healthcare West Florida Division, our nurses are leading the way with seven units earning national Unit of Distinction awards, placing them in the top five percent. Honorable mention awards went to an additional eight units, placing them in the top six to 10 percent of all HCA Healthcare units.

Our commitment to the nursing profession continued with the completion of a \$2 million Center for Clinical Advancement, located in Brandon. Here nurses can train in a state-of-the-art simulation center. Among them are 638 new graduate nurses in the Nurse Residency StaRN program, which provides support to new nurses as they enter the profession. With HCA Healthcare's partnership with the Galen School of Nursing, locally we were able to add a campus at Northside Hospital providing opportunities for students to gain valuable hospital experience.

Additionally, we supported 5,606 nursing students through agreements with local nursing schools. Our goal is to encourage nurses to earn advance certifications and degrees.



Innovative & Specialized Care

We are committed to providing the most advanced care for our patients, with specialty programs including:

Bariatrics (Weight Loss Surgery)

A wide range of weight loss surgical options and the latest advancements in bariatric care are available through the Florida Bariatric Centers at **Brandon Regional Hospital**, **Citrus Memorial Hospital**, **Largo Medical Center**, **Memorial Hospital of Tampa**, and **Palms of Pasadena Hospital**.

The programs hold a number of accreditations including adolescent qualifications at **Palms of Pasadena Hospital**.

Behavioral Health

Our collaborative network includes behavioral health ERs, inpatient programs, senior units, partial hospitalization, intensive outpatient programs, and electroconvulsive therapy. HCA Healthcare West Florida is one of the largest acute care hospital systems supporting the behavioral health needs of the many communities we serve.

Burn Care

Blake Medical Center is one of only six burn programs in Florida, designated by Florida's Agency for Healthcare Administration. Here patients are provided the latest in surgical, inpatient, and outpatient care for burn patients.

Cancer Care

HCA's Sarah Cannon Cancer Research Institute is the largest sponsor of clinical trials in the country, providing our patients access to the latest treatment options, through our Oncology and Radiation Oncology specialists. Seven hospitals in west Florida have cancer programs accredited by the American College of Surgeons Commission on Cancer.

Cardiovascular Services

Our hospitals provide some of the most sophisticated life-saving cardiac services available including cardiac surgery, cardiac catheterization, EP, mitral clip, minimally invasive valve surgery, and cardiac transplantation. Nurse navigators are available to assist patients and support them through their recovery.

Diabetes Management

Several HCA Healthcare West Florida hospitals offer diabetes management and education programs, to assist newly diagnosed patients and to provide ongoing education support. The American Diabetes Association accredited Diabetes Self-Management program is available at **Blake Medical Center**.

Emergency Care

Our hospitals are leaders in developing ER processes to enhance patient care and reduce wait times, as we continue to expand services through freestanding ERs. Today we offer 27 convenient ER 24/7® locations to provide access to emergency care.

Heart Failure Clinic

Staffed by a board-certified acute care nurse practitioner, this outpatient program can bridge the gap between hospital discharge and the patient's follow up appointment with their primary care physician or a cardiologist. Rapid hospital follow-up, comprehensive heart failure education for the patient and family, medical therapy consistent with evidence-based practices, and emergent intravenous diuretic therapy are available.

Inpatient Rehabilitation Centers

In these specialty programs, patients receive comprehensive treatment from a multidisciplinary team in the hospital setting.

The goal is to provide our patients the full range of support and resources they need to get back to their lives. **Blake Medical Center, Fawcett Memorial Hospital, Largo Medical Center** and **Palms of Pasadena Hospital** offer this specialty service.

Neurosciences & Stroke

All HCA Healthcare West Florida Hospitals are accredited Primary Stroke Centers, staffed and equipped to provide life-saving care. As we work to build the largest stroke network along Florida's west coast, **Brandon Regional Hospital, Fawcett Memorial Hospital, Northside Hospital, and Regional Medical Center Bayonet Point** have earned state designation as Comprehensive Stroke Centers providing patients immediate access to neurointerventional services.

Largo Medical Center will also open a Comprehensive Stroke Center in 2020.

Obstetrics

Our five programs serve families along Florida's west coast and include **Citrus Memorial Hospital** and **St. Petersburg General Hospital**. **Brandon Regional Hospital, Medical Center of Trinity, and Oak Hill Hospital** provide NICU services.

Pediatrics

Brandon Regional Hospital and **Oak Hill Hospital** provide a wide range of pediatric services. Brandon's program includes a Pediatric ER, Level III NICU, Pediatric Intensive Care Unit, and a wide range of pediatric specialists, and surgeons.

Surgical Solutions & Robotics

HCA West Florida is one of the largest providers of surgical services along Florida's west coast, with 132 surgical suites. Here patients can receive compassionate and expert care, conveniently. From single incision surgery to the latest in robotics, our hospitals are continuously upgrading surgical equipment to ensure our surgeons have access to the latest technology and techniques.

Telemedicine

Technological improvements are expanding telemedicine programs and services in the hospital setting, allowing us to connect quickly to specialists. Tele-Burn, Tele-Neurology and Tele-Psychiatry are allowing patients to be diagnosed and treated quicker, and in the comfort and convenience of their local hospital. HCA West Florida continues to expand its telemedicine capabilities for the safety and convenience of our patients.

Transplant

Largo Medical Center is a United Network for Organ Sharing (UNOS) and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) approved Transplant Center offering skilled surgeons and support teams to patients needing heart, kidney, and liver transplant services. The hospital serves patients nationwide, providing compassionate care and support to patients and their families.

Left Ventricular Assist Device (LVAD) implants are also performed here and patients can continue to receive support and care through our highly regarded heart failure center.

Trauma

Blake Medical Center and **Regional Medical Center Bayonet Point** are designated Level II Trauma Centers by the Florida Department of Health. Both are staffed and equipped around the clock for this high-level of emergency care.

Women's Services

Recognizing the unique needs of women, our hospitals offer a wide range of services from the latest in digital mammography to minimally invasive and robotic gynecologic surgery options.

Wound Care & Hyperbaric Medicine

These centers provide highly specialized wound care to patients suffering from diabetic ulcers, pressure ulcers, infections, and other chronic wounds that have not healed in a reasonable amount of time. Leading edge treatments may include negative pressure wound therapy, bioengineered tissues, biosynthetic dressings, and growth factor therapies. Hyperbaric oxygen therapy works by surrounding the patient with 100 percent oxygen to help progress wound healing.

Additionally, Blake offers ER 24/7®, a Joint Replacement and Spine Institute, Heart and Vascular Center, Breast Care Center, Limb Saving Institute, Lung Care Center, Advanced Primary Stroke Center, premier neuroscience services, cancer care, inpatient and outpatient rehabilitation, and physical therapy services, complex hand repair, and 24/7 hyperbaric medicine. Blake's extensive range of surgical services includes metabolic and bariatric, microvascular, open heart, neurological, colorectal, urologic, and general surgery.
